Fund for Women and Girls members multiply the impact of their giving by studying issues affecting women and girls, pooling their financial contributions to enhance the impact, and collaboratively directing the fund's grantmaking.

Why should I join?

How do I become a voting member?

Contribute \$1,500 or more annually to the Fund. If you are under 40, contribute \$250 or more.

What does collective philanthropy mean?

Combine your contribution with Fund members to enable investments in local nonprofits: \$25,000 1-year grants and \$75,000 3-year grants annually.

Who decides which local nonprofits receive funding?

You do! Voting members can review annual applications, visit potential grantees, and determine grant awards.

Can I get involved in the grantmaking process?

Absolutely. After becoming a voting member, join the Grants Committee. Learn how to evaluate applications and read financial statements, and engage in meaningful deliberations.
