## **Why should I join?**

Engage in collective philanthropy and grantmaking that supports the most vulnerable women and children in our community

## **How do I become a voting member?**

Contribute \$1500 or more annually to the Fund; or if you are under 40, contribute \$250 or more

## **What does collective philanthropy mean?**

Combine your contribution with Fund members to enable investments in local nonprofits: \$25,000 1-year grants and \$75,000 3-year grants annually

## **Who decides which local nonprofits receive funding?**

You do! Voting members can review annual applications, visit potential grantees, and determine grant awards at the annual grantmaking dinner

## **What happens at the annual Grantmaking Dinner?**

Hear the presentations of finalist organizations and cast your vote to fund our grantee partners for one or more years
